

## Worksheet 10, May 10, 2016

I advise you to work through the following problems /questions well and as a group (make sure though that no one is free-riding); it's the ticket to performing reasonably well on the exams. Number of points indicates the expected scope of the answer (should roughly correspond to time in minutes).

- 1) [15 points] *“There is no point in one country cutting its emissions if others do not. But this does not mean that a Kyoto-type approach -- a global treaty specifying exact binding limits on emissions, regardless of the consequences -- is the way to go. The difficulties in that method are obvious and have been amply demonstrated.”* Clive Crook. Discuss.
- 2) [10 points] *“Low targets, goals dropped: Copenhagen ends in failure.”* Discuss roots and consequences of Copenhagen failure.
