Once again, it is very important to note that you stay during the entire time of the mini-conference. Please remember that your performance at the mini-conference will make up a part of your grade. Consequently

those that will not participate at the mini-conference will have to work harder on the final assignment paper in order to keep a good grade.

After the mini-conference, you can choose to incorporate/address the comments that you received at the mini-conference from your fellow students and the teachers into the final version of your assignment – in order to improve your assignment. You will have 3 and ½ weeks to “revise and resubmit” your assignment, the deadline for the final version of your paper is Sunday April 10th 2016.
